The "ieh" Sound: "Shorongshoor""Y"

The sound "ieh" is a common ending of many works in the Maay language. This sound usually occurs at the end of many nouns and verbs. On occasion, this sound can be found in the middle of some words. Example:

misgieh = sorghum miehfadaaw = I do not want it usbieh = worry-beads diehdaar = caressing doorieh = chicken adieh = you

Like many others who have attempted to find standard alphabet for the Maay language, finding a letter that represents this sound has been a challenge. Here are some of the letters suggested to be used to represent this sound: ieh, h, i, ih, e', and y. For example the letter "h" has been selected by a group of Maay researchers. We tested it to see if it can be used to represent the ieh sound. Notice how the use of letter "h" is appropriate in the following words:

doorh = chichen mingdilyh= hut However the letter "h" does not work when used in the following words:

misgh (misg-h) = sorghum
shaash (shaa-sh) = head scurf
dersh (ders-h) = shed
```

The letters "gh" and "sh" are part of the Maay alphabet and they represent other sound.

The use of "hh" and "ih" were eliminated at initial stages of our research for they presented a consistence problem, because there are letters in the Maay alphabet that have the letter "H" as part of them for example, jh, th, sh, gh and dh. The letter "e'" was then considered. It consists of the letter "e" and an apostrophe. This letter could be used to represent the "ieh" sound; however, there were two problems. This letter is not found as one letter on most conventional typewriters and it involves two key strokes. However, it can be adapted easily with the use of computers and some modern typewriters. Considerable effort has been put in finding a suitable letter for this sound that does not require special typewriters and the use of computers. In addition, it was suggested that we adopt letters such as x, c, z. After long discussion, the committee has agreed to adopt the use of "y" similar to the way "y" is used in some English words such as lorry, energy, crazy, ugly, and angry. letter "y" is used both as consonant and vowel. The word "Shorongshoor"-one that changes its role-is then coined for the letter "y" because of its double role. The following rule has been put together to clarify when one can use "y" as a consonant and as a vowel:

b) If the letter "y" is preceded by a vowel it is used as consonant and is pronounced as it is "y".
 Example:

p) On the other hand, if the letter "y" is preceded by a consonant, then the letter "y" is used like vowel and is pronounced as "eih". Example:

In the Maay alphabet, only letters "R" and "L" are doubled within some words. Example:

The letters **b**, **d**, **g**, and **n** are stressed when they are part of a word, but they are not doubled within a word. When they are not stressed, the letter **p**, **th**, **gh**, and **ng** are used respectively in their place. Note how the following words are pronounced.

Specail letters: (P, Jh, Th, Gh, Ng, and Yc)

These letters are used as follows:

P:

The letter "p" always occur in the middle of a word. There is no word that starts with the letter "P". This sound is produced by the lips. Its' sound is somewhat similar to the letter "p" in the English alphabet.

pa: apaal = gratitude

pe: heped = chest
pi: Hapiipy = a name of a person
po: hopoog = scarf for married women
pu: hapung = lush py: opy = placenta

Jh:

It is guttural and it has similar sound as "j".

jha: jhab = fracture jhe: jheer = shyness

jhi: jhiir = name of a grazing land North East of Baidoa

jho: jholow

jhu: jhuus = sound jhy: jhyring = beard,

galaangihy = wooden spoon

Th:

It is pronounced as the article "the" in the English language.

tha: mathel = appointment the: etheb - permise
thi: ithing = permise
= black = politeness = permission

thu: uthug = good smell

thy: mathy = head

Gh:
It sound like the " E " of the Arabic alphabet.

Ng:

It is similar to the end sound of many English words (e.g., morning, caring, helping)

Yc:

The sound that the letter "yc" represents is also found in the words signore, bisogno, and agnello of the Italian language.

Before we decided the letter "yc" we have tried yh, yn, and ny.

Yh:

There is no problem when used in the following words muy hy = sour milk maay hy = oceans

Note that the use of the letter "yh" in the Maay word "beyhaw", which means fortunate, violates the sound that it represents because this word is read as "bey-how". Also, the rule is violated when used in the word "telyhaang" that mean as an advice. The "y" is used as vowel to read as "ieh".

Yn:

Again the letter yn was tried. The letter works according to the sound it represents when used in the word "Muyny" (sour milk). However, it fails when used in the following words:

"haayny" = we have (it is pronounced as haay-ny)
"leeyni" = we have finished (leey-ni)

Ny:

Similarly the letter "ny" was considered. Note how the letter "ny" works in the words "munyy" (sour milk) and "maanyy" (ocean). However, it fails when we want to represent the Maay the word "haayny" that means "we have".
