DECREE LAW No. 16 of 19 October 1969.
Appointment of Commission of Inquiry.

THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC

HAVING SEEN Article 63 of the Constitution;
CONSIDERING that it is necessary and urgent to appoint
Commission of Inquiry to ascertain, evaluate and report upon il
facts relating to the assassination of the late President of the Re
public, Dr. Abdirashid Ali Shermarke;
ON THE PROPOSAL of the Prime Minister;
HAVING HEARD the Council of Ministers;

DECREES:

Article 1

A Commission is hereby appointed consisting of:

Article 2

The purposes of the Commission shall be to examine all evid-
ence and make such investigation as the Commission finds deside--
rable to evaluate all the facts and circumstances surrounding the
assassination of the late President of the Republic, Dr. Abdirashid
Ali Shermarke and to report to the Prime Minister its findings and'

Article 3

1. In the execution of its functions, the Commission shall have
the same powers and limitations thereto as pertain to the judiciary
authority.

2. The Commission is empowered to prescribe its own proce-
dure and to employ such assistants as it deems necessary.

Article 4

Necessary expenses of the Commission shall be met from the
funds of the Presidency of the Council'of Ministers.

Article 5

All Ministries peripheral organs of the State and the public
shall furnish the Commission with such facilities, services and
cooperation as it may request from time to time.

Article 6

This Decree-Law shall come into force on the date of it's publi-
cation in the Official Bulletin and shall be presented to the National
Assembly for conversion into law under the terms of Article 63 of
the Constitution.
