**Law No. 32 of Customs Tariffs of P.T.A.**

**Having Seen:** The Constitution of the Somali Democratic Republic;

**Having taken Note:** The approval of the standing committee of the People Assembly.

**HEREBY ISSUES  
THE FOLLOWING LAW:**

*Art. 1*

1. Commodities originating or manufactured in member countries of P.T.A. as specified in the common list and imported into the S.D.R. shall have the reduction of the import duties prescribed in art. 2 (1) below.
2. The countries whose commodities shall be entitled to the reduction of import duties shall be those members who have ratified the treaty of the P.T.A.

*Art. 2*

1. Commodities imported from member countries of the P.T.A. shall have preferential treatment of import duty accordance with columns A, B, and C of the common list, where in the case of column A 51% or more, column B 40% and less than 51% and columns C 30% but less than 40% of the equity of the producer of such commodity is held by a person or a National Corporation, Institution, Agencies or Enterprises of a member states of P.T.A.
2. The Administrative and Statistical charges specified in Law No. 3 of 10/1/1978 shall also be reduced from the commodities described in paragraph 1 of this article in accordance with columns A, B, and C, of the common list.
